



Coalition of Persons with Disabilities - Newfoundland and Labrador 2017 Scholarships Application Package

The Coalition of Persons with Disabilities – Newfoundland and Labrador (COD-NL), in partnership with Scotiabank and Husky Energy is pleased to provide three (3) scholarships to high school students who self-identify as living with a disability, and entering post-secondary studies in September 2017.

To be eligible, candidates must be:

- Graduating from high school;
- A Canadian citizen who self-identifies as living with a disability;
- Entering a Canadian post-secondary institution; and
- Unrelated to any member of the COD-NL Board of Directors.

Selection Committee:

The Coalition of Persons with Disabilities - Newfoundland and Labrador Scholarship Program is administered by a Selection Committee, comprised of representatives from the Coalition's Board of Directors, Husky Energy, Scotiabank, and community partners from other disability organizations.

Selection Criteria:

The criteria considered in awarding the scholarship includes academic achievements, community engagement, and academic and career goals.

To Submit:

The Application is 4 pages in length and is found on pages 3 – 6 of this package. Supporting documents are required and are outlined in the Submission Guide on page 2.

Submission Guide

All applications for the Coalition of Persons with Disabilities Newfoundland and Labrador 2017 Scholarships must be accompanied by the following three (3) supporting documents:

- 1. One letter of reference from a past or current teacher;
- 2. One letter of reference from a person who has known the applicant for a minimum of one year, other than a relative; and
- 3. Official academic transcripts covering the last two (2) years of study.

Please note that official final marks will be requested from successful candidates.

Candidates must ensure that all pages of this application are complete, including signature of school representative found on page 6 of this package.

Completed applications are due no later than 4pm on Friday, May 19th, 2017.

Scholarship winners will be notified by Friday, June 2nd, 2017 and asked to attend our Annual General Meeting and Inclusion Awards on Thursday, June 8th 2017



Scotiabank Scholarship - \$1000

The Scotiabank scholarship is valued at \$1000.00 and will be awarded to one (1) successful candidate. Students entering any area of post-secondary study are encouraged to apply.

Husky Energy Scholarship - \$1250
