Dear Principal/Guidance Counsellor:

As you may be aware Memorial University recently revised its general undergraduate Entrance Scholarship Program in order to balance the program goals with available funding. Below are the details of these changes that may be of interest to your students at this time:

- Fall 2015, entrance scholarships will be valued at either \$2,550 or \$1,275. These values are equivalent to tuition fees for two semesters (10 courses/30 credit hours of full-time study) and one semester (5 courses/15 credit hours of full-time study) respectively.
- These will be offered at a ratio of approximately two \$2,550 entrance scholarships for each \$1,275 scholarship offered.
- Early offers will be made to eligible candidates who have been recommended by their high school and who have applied for admission to Memorial by the March 1<sup>st</sup> deadline.
- Offers will be made in late March based upon early scholarship averages in descending order of average until all funds have been offered.
- Please note that while only students with a 90% early average will be considered for an early offer, we cannot predict what the cutoff average will be.
- A minimum final admission average of 90% will be required in order to maintain entrance scholarship eligibility.
- Final entrance scholarship eligibility, for those who receive early offers, will be confirmed in August.
- Any funds that are available in August will be allocated with additional (late) entrance scholarship offers for eligible students who have not already received an offer. Again, meeting the 90% minimum average does not guarantee a late entrance scholarship offer as this will be subject to the availability of funding at that time.

As per our usual practice, we will contact you in January 2015 to request nominations of potential scholarship candidates so that we can ensure that we have current grades for eligible students during the early offer process.

Warren and Catherine Ball Memorial Entrance Scholarship (limited number)	<b>\$30,000</b> (\$7,500 x 4 years)
<p><b>NL HIGH SCHOOL APPLICANTS</b> who are Canadian citizens or permanent residents are automatically considered based on mid-term results provided by high schools. <b>A minimum final admission average of 90% is required.</b> No separate scholarship application is required.</p>	
Memorial University Alumni Entrance Scholarships (limited number)	<b>\$25,000</b> (\$5,000 x 5 years)
<p><b>NL HIGH SCHOOL APPLICANTS</b> who are Canadian citizens or permanent residents are considered based on academic excellence, community involvement, national and international achievements, demonstrated leadership in school and extracurricular activities. Check with your guidance counsellor for details. <b>A minimum final admission average of 90% is required.</b> A separate scholarship application is required.</p>	
Dr. Leslie Harris Memorial University Alumni Association Scholarships (limited number)	<b>\$16,000</b> (\$4,000 x 4 years)
<p><b>NL HIGH SCHOOL APPLICANTS</b> who are Canadian citizens or permanent residents are considered based on academic excellence, community involvement, national and international achievements, and demonstrated leadership in school and extracurricular activities. Check with your guidance counsellor for details. <b>A minimum final admission average of 90% is required.</b> A separate scholarship application is required.</p>	
NON-RENEWABLE SCHOLARSHIPS	
Memorial University Entrance Scholarships (limited number)	
<p><b>HIGH SCHOOL APPLICANTS</b> who are Canadian citizens or permanent residents are eligible based on admission average. Scholarships valued at \$2550 (equivalent to 10 courses/30 credit hours of full-time study) and \$1275 (equivalent to 5 courses/15 credit hours of full-time study) will be awarded as funding allows. <b>A minimum final admission average of 90% is required.</b> No separate scholarship application is required.</p>
