

YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP NOTICE

Again this year, Newfoundland Labrador Housing (NLHC) will be awarding scholarships to children of NLHC tenants. Six \$1,000 youth scholarships will be awarded, two each in Avalon/East, Central, and Western/Labrador regions, to students graduating from high school in June 2017.

These youth scholarships will be open to children whose legal guardians are either:

- 1) renting from NLHC (excluding market rentals)
- 2) receiving a rent supplement from NLHC,
- 3) receiving a mortgage subsidy from NLHC, or
- 4) residing in Co-op Housing or Partner-Managed Housing which is subsidized by NLHC.

In addition to graduating from high school this year, applicants must attend on a full-time basis in the fall of 2017 any post-secondary education or career training institution approved by the Newfoundland and Labrador Department of Education. The scholarships will be awarded based on the results of the Department of Education Scholarship Score which is derived from a student's performance on the 2017 Newfoundland and Labrador Provincial Public Exams.

Enclosed is a copy of the scholarship application and a notice for you to post on your bulletin board to alert students and teachers of the availability of these scholarships. If you are aware of any students that would be eligible to apply, please encourage them to do so.

Scholarship applications must be postmarked no later than August 31, 2017.

What makes you eligible for a Youth Scholarship?

To be eligible for NLHC's Youth Scholarship Program, your legal guardian(s) would have to be either:

- 1) renting from NLHC, and their signature(s) appear on the rental lease;
- 2) receiving a rent supplement from NLHC;
- 3) receiving a mortgage subsidy from NLHC, and their signature(s) appear on the mortgage document; or
- 4) living in Co-op housing or Partner-Managed housing which is being subsidized by NLHC and their signature(s) appear on the occupancy agreement or lease.

You must also meet the following eligibility requirements:

- 1) graduating from the Newfoundland and Labrador high school system in the current school year (June 2017);
- 2) attending a program of study at any approved post-secondary education or career training institution on a full-time basis in the fall of 2017.

NOTE:

- 1) Information on the application form must be valid at the time the application is reviewed for eligibility.
- 2) Should you change post-secondary institutions after you submit your application, you are responsible to contact NLHC at 724-3003 to have your application updated.
- 3) Tenants living in NLHC's Market-Rental housing are not eligible to apply.
- 4) Youth Scholarships will be awarded based on the results of the Newfoundland and Labrador department of Education Scholarship Score which is derived from a student's performance on the 2017 Newfoundland and Labrador Provincial Public Exams. There is no need to attach high school marks to your application.

REMEMBER:

To be considered for a Youth Scholarship, you only need to meet the criteria listed above, then fill out and mail in the application. No need to include any other documentation -- unless you decide not to give NLHC permission to obtain confirmation of your post-secondary registration, then you will need to ensure your registration confirmation is postmarked or received by NLHC by August 31, 2017. Note, incomplete applications will not be considered for a scholarship.
