

A Scholarship Fund for Engineering Students in Atlantic Canada

Who is eligible?

To be eligible for this award, applicants must be graduating from an Atlantic Canadian High school in June and entering their first year of full-time studies in an Engineering Program at a University in Atlantic Canada the following September.

What are the selection criteria?

Applicants will be adjudicated upon the basis of their character, financial need and academic standing.

What is the value?

The value of the award is \$15,000 per academic school year. The award will be applied directly to the recipient's student account at the University they are attending. If there is a remaining balance, a cheque will be issued to the student for other education-related expenses.

Is the Award Renewable?

The scholarship is eligible to be renewed by the award winner for up to four years provided that the student maintains a reasonable standing in the program (as determined by the Donor in his sole discretion). However, the Donor reserves the right to award scholarships on a more or less frequent basis as income levels and the Foundation permit.

How do you apply?

The subject line of the email must include your last name, first name and the name of the scholarship for which you are applying. The following information is required:

- □ An application form (please feel free to use more space, if needed)
- □ A brief explanation of why you are requesting financial support (500 words or less)
- □ A brief explanation of why you chose Engineering as your field of study (500 words or less)
- □ Two letters of reference

Successful applicant(s) will be required to submit:

- A confirmation letter from a university of acceptance into an Engineering program.
- Grade 12 final transcripts.
