<p>Deadlines</p> <p>December 1, 2016 Major Admission Awards Application</p> <p>February 15, 2017 Admission Bursary Application</p>	<p>Queen's Major Admission Awards</p> <p>Deadline: December 1, 2016</p> <p><i>Available to Canadian Citizens and Permanent Residents of Canada</i></p> <p>Major Admission Award applicants are students who stand out for their academic excellence, demonstrated leadership, community and/or school involvement and their original and creative thinking. Each year we grant more than 70 Major Admission Awards valued between \$36,000 to \$80,000 over 4 years.</p> <p>We encourage all applicants to apply for admission to Queen's through the Ontario Universities' Application Centre (OUAC) prior to the Major Admission Award Application deadline. Students who are unable to apply for admission prior to the deadline must still submit their Major Admission Award Application by December 1.</p> <p>Nomination Process for the Chancellor's Scholarship</p> <p>Applications for the Chancellor's Scholarship are submitted via a nomination process. Depending on your high school's graduating class size, your school may be eligible to nominate between one and three candidates as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> < 250: 1 nominee, 250 to 499: 2 nominees, > 500: 3 nominees. <p>We encourage high schools with more than one nomination to also consider nominating students with diverse desired programs of university study.</p>
<p>QuARMS</p> <p>Candidates wishing to be considered for the Queen's University Accelerated Route to Medical School (QuARMS) must be nominated by their high school for the Chancellor's Scholarship.</p> <p>Within each school's respective nominee guidelines, only 1 QuARMS candidate may be nominated regardless of the graduating class size. Visit queensu.ca/admission for further information.</p>	<p>Admission Bursary Application</p> <p>Deadline: February 15, 2017</p> <p><i>Available to Canadian Citizens and Permanent Residents of Canada</i></p> <p>Admission bursaries are non-repayable grants based on demonstrated financial need. There is an expectation that students applying for admission bursary assistance will also be accessing government student financial assistance.</p> <p>Admission bursaries are offered at the time a student is offered admission to Queen's. We want students to be informed of their financial options at the same time they are making decisions about their offer of admission. This means we require students to submit their Admission Bursary Application early (apply at the same time you apply for admission to Queen's).</p>

2 All applicants must demonstrate superior academic ability, proven leadership qualities and creative/original thinking.

3 IB Diploma Programme minimum grade 36 core.

4 Students will not receive more than one merit-based award. In some cases an award will not be available to a student who has already been granted an award of equal or greater value.

5 To be eligible for the Senator Frank Carrel Merit Scholarship you must be a Canadian citizen or Permanent Resident of Canada and a resident of the province of Quebec.

6 The values and admission averages shown for admission scholarships, bursaries and awards were in effect at the time of publication. Queen's University reserves the right to revise or withdraw any award without prior notice.

7 Generally, students must maintain a GPA of 3.5 or higher in a full course load each year to renew. Some additional conditions for renewal may apply.

8 The Dean's Admission Scholarship for Arts & Science is applicable for students admitted into the Bachelor of Arts & Science (Honours) degree program.

9 To be eligible for the International Entrance Scholarship you must be an international student. To be eligible for the Principal's International Scholarship—India you must be an international student from India.
