Reducing Stressors

When stress starts to build up, the ideal solution is to reduce the amount you're exposed to

What are my options?

- Solve the problem
- Build knowledge or skills
- Reduce exposure
- Change my behaviour and/or my reactions
- Create boundaries
- Become more organized

Coping with Stress

Some stress cannot be completely reduced. There are two main parts to coping:

- Being able to tolerate stress when it's happening
- Recovering and bouncing back when the stressful situation is over

What strategy works best for your situation?

- Change the way you think
- Reach out for support
- Learn new coping strategies
- Make lifestyle changes
- Seek professional help
